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Summary of Findings

Civic Participation Statistics

Up to 300 People* Participated in giving their input into New Glasgow's Smart Cities Challenge

163 People at the Farmer's Market + 137 Online Surveys**

167 People Participated in the Surveys

(137 Filled in online surveys

+ 30 People gave short comments at NG's Farmer's Market)

Total Comments = 1,213***

(1,175 Online; Average of 8.58 Comments / Person

+ 38 from Farmer's Market; Average of 1.27 Comments / Person)

163 People Participated in the Voting for Priorities at the Farmer's Market

Total Votes Cast = 871

Average of 5.34 Priority Areas / Person

**These numbers do not include the 20+ citizens of New Glasgow or Pictou County who were actively involved in engaging other citizens or in creating the proposal.*

***All 30 of the people who gave comments at the New Glasgow Farmer's Market also voted on priorities, therefore they were previously included as part of the 163 at the Farmer's Market. Therefore, the maximum number of unique respondents to the online survey is 137.*

****In this incredibly large task under time pressure, if one comment was relevant in three areas, then it went into all three nodes in the World Systems Model, and would have been counted 3 times. Moving forward, it is recommended to have a system of allowing data points to be entered multiple times without being counted a 'separate points'.*
